Mr Gough,

Thank you for your letter dated 4 April 2009 together with enclosed drawing no.OF-PP-001 in relation to the above.

I have liaised with Ian Walshaw at our North Divisional Office (whom you forwarded a copy) and can confirm that the construction details are acceptable to this authority and the areas to be improved accord with the discussions that were held on site.

Having regard to the extent of the highway improvements I do not consider that they can be carried out under Section 184 (11) of the Highways Act 1980. In the circumstances we can agree to Enterprise, as our Term Contractor, carrying out these works at your client's expense. Alternatively the works could be carried out under a Section 278 Agreement which would allow your client to seek alternative prices from approved contractors. I wait hearing from you on this matter.
