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- - - - - Footpath
- - - - - Restricted Byway

Clean water from roof and clean surfaces to open and stone filled infiltration trenches and a piped system each side of building. This will discharge into existing soakaways.  
At the wash down stage the clean water system around the yard will be switched to the underground dirty water tank.

Dirty water from wash down will be collected in an underground sealed tank, which will be constructed to meet the SSAFO Regulations (Wales) 2010 Standards. This will then be tankered out and spread on the applicants land in accordance with the manure management plan.

The clean and foul water drainage systems will be kept separate in order to ensure no pollution incident occurs to the environment.
