

Erection residential development and associated works at Land at Maes Dinas, Llanfechain, SY22 6YR

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#### 1. Introduction

This statement is written in connection with the planning application for the proposed residential development at Land at Maes Dinas, Llanfechain, SY22 6YR.

Suds perform an important role in managing run-off from a site, and must be implemented in any development comprising of construction work that equals or exceeds 100m2.

This statement outlines that the applicant has had due regard to the Suds Legislation when considering this scheme, and outlining indicatively how the proposal will comply with the necessary criterion set out in the SAB guidance.

## 2. Existing Site

The existing site is improved agricultural grassland with existing field drains running across and down the field.

### 3. Surface water management

The proposed residential development will indeed mean impermeable areas being created on existing impermeable ground. The proposal will include rainwater harvesting, swales, soakaways which will ensure the proposal complies with the SAB hierarchy.

### 4. Maintenance and Management

The drainage scheme will be maintained throughout its lifetime by a management company
